

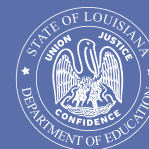

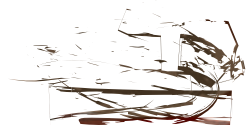

Introduction

This report contains the average composite, English, mathematics, reading, and science American College Test (ACT) scores at both the district and school levels. The averages were computed by using the ACT scores most recently obtained by the students who were or would have been members of the Louisiana 2009 graduating class. Scores are reported for **public schools only**, including the laboratory schools and the Louisiana School for Mathematics, Science and the Arts (Natchitoches Parish). The state and national average scores, however, were computed using the scores of both public and nonpublic school students. The national average composite score includes the 49 other states and the District of Columbia. The first table provides the district, state, and national average composite scores for 2005 through 2009. The remaining tables provide the 2009 school-level scores.

Summary of ACT Results

- The average composite score for Louisiana public and nonpublic students decreased two-tenths of a point to 20.1 in 2009 after increasing two-tenths of a point to 20.3 in 2008. Louisiana's composite ACT score has increased by three-tenths of a point since 2005.
- The average national ACT composite score for 2009 was 21.1, unchanged from 2008 and two-tenths of a point higher than in 2005.
- Louisiana's public and nonpublic students combined showed a decrease in average scores in English, math and reading, while the average score in science remained the same as in 2008.
- Twenty-three of Louisiana's public school districts had increased average composite scores from 2008. Red River Parish showed the biggest gain of any public school district, increasing from 17.5 in 2008 to 19.3 in 2009, a 1.8-point jump. Thirty-six districts had decreased average composite scores from 2008, and five districts maintained the same average composite score.
- Louisiana ACT test takers in the class of 2009 increased this year from 34,211 to 34,548, an all-time high record since Hurricane Katrina.
- Fee waivers contributed significantly to rising participation among low-income students. In 2008-2009, 16,661 fee waivers for the ACT exam were issued in Louisiana as compared to 12,967 in 2007-2008. This represents a twenty-eight percent increase.
- The ethnic group composition of the Louisiana population of ACT testers contained 20,423 (59%) Caucasian-American/White students, 10,530 (30%) African-American/Black students, and 3,595 (11%) from other ethnic groups.
- Louisiana was one of ten states with a high proportion of high school graduates taking the ACT, including Colorado (100 percent), Kentucky (100 percent), Michigan (100 percent), Wyoming (99 percent), Illinois (97 percent), Mississippi (93 percent), Tennessee (92 percent), Louisiana (89 percent), North Dakota (78 percent), and Alabama (76 percent). The percent of Louisiana graduates taking the ACT increased one point, from 88 percent in 2008 to 89 percent in 2009. Nationally, 45 percent of graduates took the ACT.
- In a ranking of ACT composite scores for the sixteen Southern Regional Education Board (SREB) states, Louisiana's average was ranked twelfth, above the averages of South Carolina (19.8), Florida (19.5), Kentucky (19.4), and Mississippi (18.9). Louisiana's average falls below Arkansas (20.6) and Alabama (20.3).
